

Local 1271 Award Nomination Form

Any member of Local 1271 can nominate a fellow member or an individual for one of the following awards by filling out the nomination form and sending it to the Union Registrar. Nominations will be collected throughout the year up to May 1st of the presenting year, with the winners being announced at the annual Union awards night.

Meritorious Conduct

Members whose actions in the line of duty that go above and beyond regular duty. Above and beyond the call shall not be limited to acts of bravery. Any and all other actions deemed to be beyond the normal expectations of a member acting in the course of their regular duties when serving the public and that reflects positively in the public eye on the Surrey Fire Service shall be eligible for this award.

Special Recognition

Individuals who have made a considerable contribution to the Surrey Fire Fighters in the last year.

Committee Award

A member with a minimum 5 years service who has participated on numerous committees and has made a significant impact (a minimum of 3 UNION committees), contributing to the betterment of all Local 1271 members for an extended period of time (a majority of their five years service).

Axe Award

A member with a minimum of 10 years service who has shown a dedicated and conscientious effort to uphold the standard of professionalism, reflects credit upon local 1271 on and off duty, and promotes goodwill among union brothers and sisters. They will have been contributing to the betterment of Local 1271 all members for a majority of their (ten years) service

Red Powell Award

The Firefighters, FIREFIGHTER. The recipient of this award should exemplify that of a conscientious and dedicated fire fighter. On duty and off duty who upholds the standards of our profession, reflects credit upon local 1271 and promotes goodwill among union brothers and sisters. The Red Powell recipient should have been a member of Local 1271 for 20 years or more. They will have contributed to not only the betterment of all Local 1271 members but also the people in the community, which we serve. Local 1271 is proud of them as a member and they are proud to be a member

Local 1271 Honourary Member

A Honourary member will not be in conflict with IAFF or Local union Constitution and Bylaws. They are someone who has contributed to the operational side of our profession and would be deserving of membership in local 1271 if eligible. This person will and has upheld the proud traditions of the fire service, trade unionism and demonstrate the community pride expected in a member of Local 1271 members. Local 1271 members will have benefited from having known them.

Honourary Fire Fighter

An Honorary fire fighter is someone who has contributed to the goals and objectives of Local 1271 and shown the dedication and commitment required to be a fire fighter. They will by virtue of their effort, provided Local 1271 with a positive profile in the public eye, provided Local 1271 members a sense of pride and accomplishment. A strong sense of community will be evident in their actions and achievements on behalf of Local 1271.
